Private Instruction

3 years - Adult

One-on-one instruction is offered to meet student's swimming goals. Private lessons are \$108 for a 4-day session and are generally held Mon - Thur each week during the summer lesson sessions.

Swim Level Descriptions

SRPD offers American Red Cross group lessons that include age appropriate safety topics. Most children tend to repeat levels more than once.

STARFISH 6 MO - 3 YEARS PARENT + CHILD AQUATICS

Parent or guardian must attend each class with child. Starfish emphasizes teaching the parent how to work with the child in the water through song and play. Water adjustment skills: water entry, water exploration, glides, arm and leg action, and family water safety. Only one child per adult allowed. Child must wear water diaper if not potty trained.

POLLIWOG 3 - 5 YEARS PRESCHOOL LEVEL 1

Polliwog is a swim readiness class for young children who are ready to learn without a parent in the water. Water adjustment skills: entering and exiting the water, submerging, nose bubbles, floating, gliding, kicking, arm action, and basic safety.

TURTLE 3 - 5 YEARS PRESCHOOL LEVEL 2

Turtle is for children who have successfully completed the Polliwog course or are able to glide 2 body lengths, roll over, and float for 3 seconds. Basic swimming skills: breath control, rhythmic breathing, floating, gliding, sculling, forward propulsion, kicking, arm action, and basic safety.

FROG 3 - 5 YEARS PRESCHOOL LEVEL 3

Frog is for children who have successfully completed the Turtle course or are able to swim for 6 body lengths, and float for 15 seconds. Fundamental aquatic skills: rhythmic and rotary breathing, floating, treading, sculling, forward propulsion, combined arm and leg action, elementary backstroke, and water safety.

MINNOW 6 - 12 YEARS LEARN-TO-SWIM LEVEL 1 & 2

Minnow is for first time and beginning swimmers. It is a combination of Polliwog and Turtle for school-aged kids. Introductory and fundamental swimming skills: entering and exiting the water, submerging, breath control, rhythmic breathing, floating, gliding, treading, forward propulsion, kicking, arm action, and basic safety.

GOLDFISH 5 - 14 YEARS LEARN-TO-SWIM LEVEL 3

Goldfish is for participants who have completed Frog or Minnow, or who are able to float or tread for 15 seconds and swim 5 body lengths unsupported. Stroke development skills: front crawl with rotary breathing, back crawl, elementary backstroke, treading water, breaststroke kick, and survival floating.

MANTA RAY 5 - 14 YEARS LEARN-TO-SWIM LEVEL 4

Manta Ray is for participants who have successfully completed the Goldfish class or are able to tread for 1 minute and swim 25 yards unsupported. Stroke improvement skills: front and back crawl refinement with open turns, breaststroke, butterfly, side stroke, underwater swimming, treading, introduction to diving, and survival swimming.

SEA LION 6 - 14 YEARS LEARN-TO-SWIM LEVEL 5

Sea Lion is for participants who have successfully completed the Manta Ray class or are able to swim 50 yards of the front crawl with rotary breathing and 25 yards of elementary backstroke. Stroke refinement skills: diving, surface diving, flip turns, refinement of all 6 strokes, treading, and additional water safety.

DOLPHIN 6 - 14 YEARS LEARN-TO-SWIM LEVEL 6

Dolphin is for participants who have successfully completed the Sea Lion course or are able to swim a 100 yard IM. Stroke proficiency skills: efficiency and endurance in all 6 strokes, reciprocal practice, introduction to Jr Lifeguarding and Swim Team skills, and awareness-based water safety.

OCTOPUS 3+ YEARS ADAPTIVE SWIM LESSONS

Octopus lessons are for children with disabilities who are ready to work in a group setting, but may need extra attention.


