The Sunrise Recreation and Park District (SRPD) is seeking an experienced professional contractor to provide services for replacement of the Antelope Aquatic Complex Pool Heater Replacement.

SRPD reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive any technicalities, informalities, and irregularities, to accept or reject all or any part of the proposal, and to be the sole judge of suitability on the proposal offer.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

SRPD is seeking an experienced and professional company to provide the services of replacing the Pool Heater located at Antelope Aquatic Complex.

The existing pool heating system has reached the end of its useful life and is experiencing increasing maintenance needs, operational inefficiencies, and reliability concerns. The current equipment no longer provides consistent and efficient heating necessary to support year-round aquatics programming, recreational swimming opportunities, instructional classes, and community use.

Replacement of the pool heater is necessary to maintain safe and comfortable water temperatures, reduce unplanned service interruptions, and improve overall energy efficiency.

The project consists of removing the existing heater equipment and installing a new, appropriately sized commercial-grade pool heating system, including any associated

mechanical, plumbing, electrical, and control system improvements required for proper operation and code compliance. Completion of the project will ensure continued delivery of aquatics programs and services Sunrise Recreation and Park District residents and facility users.

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work, in general, includes the following tasks but not limited to:

Removal of a Lochinvar CopperFin2 CPN2071 heater and installation of a new Raypak Hi-Delta P2002C w/cold water run.

- Disconnect plumbing, gas line, and venting
- Remove existing heater
- Move new heater into place
- Run new plumbing to heater
- Connect gas line
- Install existing 14" venting
- Install additional 20 AMP circuit
- Restore power to the heater and assure it powers up properly
- Test all gas & flue pressures
- Perform a factory startup and provide training on new heater
- Submit Air Board Permits to Sacramento County
- Perfect Nox testing

EXISTING CONDITIONS

The vendor, in undertaking the work under this contract, is to have visited the premises and to have taken into consideration all conditions which might affect the work. No consideration will be given to any claims based on lack of knowledge of existing conditions. The mandatory Pre-Bid walk date is scheduled for May 22, 2026, at 9:00am.

DEVIATIONS

Any deviations from the scope of work indicated herein must be submitted in writing to the project manager prior to the bid due date.

CHANGE ORDERS

Change orders will not be considered once the proposed bid has been accepted.

VALID CALIFORNIA CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE

Required at time of bid submission and valid through the length of the project.

PREVAILING WAGE

Pursuant to the California Labor Code Section 1720 and following this is a prevailing wage project.

DIR REGISTRATION

Contractors and subcontractors must register with the DIR and meet DIR requirements before bidding on public works contracts in California.

SUBMITTALS

The successful bidder shall be required to execute a Material and Labor Payment Bond and Performance Bond issued by a corporate surety, acceptable to the Sunrise Recreation and Park District, for the RUSCH COMMUNITY PARK POOL HEAT EXCHANGER. Each bond shall not be less than one hundred percent (100%) of that portion of the contract price.

Pursuant to California Contract Code Section 22300, the contractor may, at its own expense, substitute securities for any money being withheld by the County to ensure performance under this contract.
