Participant Guidelines

(‘The CHCMB’ refers to the Citrus Heights Community Marching Band, its administration, membership, and volunteers for this event)

- *The CHCMB reserves the right to refuse or disqualify any entry for any reason*
- *Children under age 12 must be accompanied by and supervised by an adult at all times*
- *Parade entries must complete the entire parade route*
- *Objects (such as candy) must not be thrown or tossed into the crowd from any parade entry*
- *Late or Incomplete Parade Entries may be disqualified from awards*
- *Loaded Firearms not permitted unless carried by active duty law enforcement*
- *Flammable decorations and materials will not be permitted*
- *Placement in the Parade Line-Up is at the discretion of the CHCMB*
- *The CHCMB shall not be held responsible for loss or damage to any property, vehicle, person, or animal in our event*

These guidelines are in place for the safety and enjoyment of our community. If the CHCMB feels that an entry or individual is in violation of these guidelines, we may ask the entry/individual to leave our event, and request assistance of Law Enforcement if needed.
