#### **THE POSITION:**

Sunrise Recreation and Park District is accepting applications for Assistant Swim Coach I and Assistant Swim Coach II for the Sunrise Sharks. This program is part of the Aquatics Division of the Recreation Department. The Assistant Swim Coach II is the journey level class in the job series and may require more experience, more responsibility, and a great time commitment.

Knowledge of principles and practices of competitive swimming. Knowledge of coaching practices and methods. Knowledge of current water safety and swimming rescue techniques. Knowledge of proper competitive stroke mechanics. Knowledge of materials and equipment used in competitive swimming. Knowledge of principles and techniques of effective interpersonal communication, public relations, and customer service. Ability to swim with proficiency and endurance. Ability to coach and encourage swimmers during practices and swim meets. Ability to assist with the organization of team practices and meets. Ability to work with limited supervision. Ability to exercise tact, judgment, and patience in dealing this team participants, volunteers, and other District staff.
