

RESOLUTION NO. 19-001
A RESOLUTION DIRECTING PREPARATION OF THE ENGINEER'S REPORT
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20
FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE ASSESSMENTS
FOR THE
SUNRISE RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Sunrise Recreation and Park District of (the "District"), County of Sacramento (the "County"), State of California, as follows:

1. On August 15th, 2002 by its Resolution No. 02-010, this Board ordered formation of a landscaping and lighting district pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (Part 2 of Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500 thereof) (the "District").

2. The purpose of the District is for the installation, maintenance and servicing of the improvements described in Section 4 below, including the issuance of bonds and/or notes to finance all or part of the improvements.

3. The District has been given the distinctive designation of the "Park Maintenance and Recreation Improvement District," and is primarily described as all of the lands within the communities of Antelope.

4. It is proposed that Park Maintenance and Recreation Improvement District undertake the following improvements: installation, maintenance and servicing of public facilities, as well as debt service, issuance costs and other expenses associated with the issuance and administration of bonds for the improvements. Installation will include but not be limited to, construction of recreational improvements, playing fields, playground equipment, senior and community centers, hard court surfaces, tennis courts, recreational facilities, public restrooms, irrigation and sprinkler systems, landscaping, turf and track facilities, gymnasiums, swimming pools, park grounds, park facilities, landscape corridors, and trails, as applicable, for property owned or maintained by the Sunrise Recreation and Park District. Maintenance means the furnishing of services and materials for the ordinary and usual maintenance, operation and servicing of said improvements, including repair, removal, or replacement of all or part of any improvement; providing for the life, growth, health and beauty of landscaping; and cleaning, sandblasting and painting of walls and other improvements to remove or cover graffiti. Servicing means the furnishing of electric current or energy for the operation or lighting of any improvements, and water for irrigation of any landscaping or

the maintenance of any other improvements.

5. SCI Consulting Group is hereby designated as Engineer of Work for purposes of these proceedings and is hereby ordered to prepare an Engineer's Report for continuation of the assessments in accordance with Article 4 of Chapter 1 of the Act and Article XIID of the California Constitution. Upon completion, the Engineer shall file the Engineer's Report with the Clerk of the Board for submission to the Board.
